THE BRITISH MONETARY SYSTEM

The British monetary system is based on the pound sterling (£). From the 12th to 16th century, a pound sterling weighed one full pound of 240 silver pennies. During the following centuries, the pound was progressively devalued. After the currency reforms of 1816, a pound sterling was made of 240 large copper pennies weighing exactly one pound. These pennies were made of bronze after 1860.

Paper money (banknotes) are referred to as "notes" and are issued in denominations of £5, £10, £20, £50. The 1£ note was discontinued during the 1980's and replaced with a one pound coin. Banknotes are issued by the Bank of England, although some banks in Scotland issue their own notes.

British currency, somewhat reluctantly, changed to decimalization in 1966-71. There are 100 pence (100p, pronounced "pee") in a pound. The pound is also known informally as a "quid". Today, there is no clear relationship between weight and intrinsic value of coins and a pound sterling.

Coins are currently minted in the following denominations: 1p, 2p, 5p*, 10p*, 20p, 50p, £1 & £2. Those coins issued before 1982 will have the phrase "new pence" on the back to distinguish them from the less valuable old pence worth 1/240 of a pound. The ½p coin is no longer issued. Most coins are quite heavy (substantial, as the British would say) and this is the reason the £2 coin is not popular.

(* older 5p coins will read "one shilling")
(* older 10p coins will read "two shillings")

There is also the "guinea", a unit of value that doesn't actually exist either as a coin or note. It is equal to 105p (21 shillings before 1967), and is usually used only on invoices and statements from doctors and lawyers, and very rarely in shops.

---Penny-A silver coin first issued in the 8th Century. It remained a silver coin until 1797 when a copper penny was introduced. It was reduced in size twice and since decimalization is currently worth 2.4 of the old coin. The penny is now made of bronze.

---Shilling-A silver coin first minted in 1504 and then called Teston. Its modern equivalent was superseded by the 5p coin. Also called a "bob"

Before 1966, the old system of currency was rather confusing, especially for those not familiar with it. There are a great many terms used which are rarely heard of today. A brief glossary of some of that terminology follows.

---Crown-a gold coin minted in 1526 and worth 22p. In 1551, it appeared as a silver coin and was valued at 25p. The crown was discontinued in Victorian times, although it has been revived for recent commemorative issues.

---Farthing-A coin worth a quarter of an old penny. Until 1279, a farthing was obtained by cutting a penny into quarters.

---Florin-A gold coin minted in 1344 and worth 30p. It took its name from Florence where Europe's first gold coin was introduced. In 1849, silver florins were first minted as a preliminary step towards decimalization of the currency. In modern times it was the name of the two-shilling coin, superseded by the modern 10p.

---Guinea-A gold coin worth £1, first minted in 1663. It was named for the place where gold was mined-Guinea in West Africa, later known as the Gold Coast. In 1717, it was revalued at 21 shillings (105p) and discontinued in 1813, although its use as a name persisted until 1966-71, when decimalization took over.

---Half Crown-A gold coin first introduced in the reign of Henry VIII, but later reissued by Edward VI as a silver coin. In modern times, before decimalization, a half crown coin was worth 12½p.

---Half Penny-Until 1279, a half penny was obtained by cutting a penny in half. Silver half pennies were issued from this date until 1672 when they were minted in copper. In 1860, in common with the penny it was made from bronze and in this form was used until decimalization, when the new ½p was introduced.

MONTANA

Montana Vital Records since 1907 are available from Bureau of Records and Statistics, State Dept. of Health and Environmental Sciences, Helena, MT. Marriage and divorce records will be with the Clerk of District Court in the county where the event occurred.

British Monetary System cont.:

---Sixpence- A silver coin first minted in 1551. In 1947, it was made of cupronickel. It was worth 2½p, but was discontinued after decimalization.

---Sovereign-A gold coin minted in 1489 which, by the reign of Elizabeth I, was worth 30 shillings.

---Unite- A gold coin minted early in the 17th Century which was named after the union of Scotland and England. It replaced the sovereign for the time being and was worth £1.

---Groat- A silver coin introduced in 1279, and reintroduced from 1351-1662. Its value was approximately 1½p. A small silver groat was later minted, but discontinued in 1855. A half-groat was introduced in 1351.

LAND RECORDS

Genealogical Importance of Land Records

- 1) In early rural America nearly every adult male can be found in land records.
- 2) Land records exist uninterrupted from early settlement to present.
- 3) Older land records contain more genealogical data than modern ones.
- 4) Land records are among the most accurate and reliable records available to genealogists.
- 5) Land records have been totally indexed over a long period of time.

How Land Records are Commonly Indexed

- 1) Alphabetically by first letter of surname only.
- 2) Alpha by first letter of surname; then alpha by given name.
- 3) Alpha by first letter and first vowel of surname.
- 4) Alpha by first letter of surname and first key letter (l,m,n,r,t).
- 5) In any index there may be special pages for surnames common in a county.
- 6) Also check under both "Sheriff" and the surname of the sheriff (see county histories). Many of our ancestors left land that was later sold by the sheriff for taxes.
