**STORIES ABOUT MY GREAT GRANDFATHER, JACOB  
EASTER, AS TOLD TO HIS GRANDCHILDREN AND  
WRITTEN DOWN BY MY UNCLE, GROVER EASTER.**

My great grandfather, Jacob Easter, was born in Bedford County, PA on August 21, 1824. His family were waggoneers on the National Pike Road built from Maryland through the Cumberland Gap of the Allegheny Mountains west into Ohio. It was built of rock by the Federal Government beginning about 1818 and ending about 1852 when the railroad took over. As many as twenty four horse coaches were counted in line at one time on the road. There were large broad wheeled wagons, covered with white canvas stretched over bows, laden with merchandise and drawn by six horses, visible all day long at every point. The road was known for the great number and excellence of its inns and taverns. They had large stables and court yards and some could put up one hundred wagons of a night or six hundred horses.

My great great grandfather, Nicholas Easter, owned a tavern called the Temple of Juno, for a short time. He lived on a farm in German Township of Fayette County, PA and had teams which he used on the road.

When Jacob Easter was sixteen years old a German man who had a line of wagons and teams that hauled on the Old Stone Pike Road offered him the best team on the road if he would drive for him. Jacob was six feet two inches and weighed 225 pounds. He was well skilled in driving and caring for horses. The first morning he was to drive, the owner of the teams took Jacob to breakfast and when they came out the stable boy had six dapple gray horses that were well matched for size hitched to the loaded wagon. Each team had large plumes attached to the hames. For eight years the road and the taverns were his home. They hauled in all kinds of weather and the loads were as large as five ton. His hauls were mostly from Cumberland, MD, through the mountains to Wheeling, West Virginia.

One day while hauling with a sled, a young fellow out hunting got on the sled to ride. He had his gun with the cap on the firing pin. When they came to a slippery place, Jacob jumped off the sled to keep it from sliding off the road. The boy, thinking it might upset, jumped also. The gun fired and the bullet hit Jacob in the shin bones, splintering both bones. He could not get the boy to help him onto the sled, so he elbowed himself onto the sled and laying on his back drove the team home. He was carried into the house and a doctor at Masontown, two mile away was sent for. Dr. Neff came and examined the leg and said it would have to be amputated. He went to town for his implements and help to perform the operation. They had everything ready to amputate when a man who lived six miles away came riding up and rushed into the house. He drew his pistol and demanded that the doctor dress the wound or he would shoot him if he cut the leg off. There was considerable argument about this. The man said he would take all the blame if anything went wrong. The doctor dressed the wound and came every day to look after the leg. At one time they had to rebreak the bones to get them in the proper place. Jacob was in bed six months with weights on his leg. However, the leg healed and was hardly noticeable. He was able to work and lived forty-five years after this event. Jacob Easter came to Kansas March 28, 1881, and lived in Dickinson County near his son, George Easter, who had come in 1879.

**THE NIGHT THE STARS FELL**

When Jacob Easter was nine years old, his brother John had gone to the stables about three o'clock in the morning to get a six-horse team ready for a haul that day. It was November 13, 1833, and the family lived in Bedford County, PA. It was then that the Great Phenomenon, often referred to as the Shooting Stars, occurred. The meteors rained down so thick that no one would venture out of buildings. This caused much excitement as some thought the world was coming to an end. Nicholas Easter called his family to get up, got them around the dining room table and began to read the Bible and pray in German. He

would go to the door and look out toward the barn and wish that John had not gone out. Then he would come back and read and pray some more. They kept this up until morning.

Jacob often told his grandchildren this story. He said that soon after this the family changed to the English language altogether. Good schools were then established and his son George was ready to go to high school when Jacob's accident occurred and George (my Grandfather) had to stay home and help with the farm work.

NOTE: Max Ary said that about 1833 Leonids Shower occurred when there were about 15,000 meteors per hour. On a clear night there would be about 1-3 per hour and if there were a meteor shower there might be 15 - 30 meteors per hour so you can see what excitement 15,000 per hour would cause. Max said they occur about every two hundred years.

DO - always enclose a SASE - Self Addressed Stamped (long) Envelope - anytime you are asking for information or expect a response.

DO - try to share information with others when you can.

DO - always acknowledge and thank someone for replying to your letter.

DO - always respond to a letter you have received even if you do not have any information to share.

DO - try to be patient. Some of us have been searching for years for one bit of information.

DO - expect to find some "horse thieves" lurking in your family tree, but

DON'T - worry about it. We're not responsible for others' actions but we are responsible for recording the truth.

DON'T - demand that others share their research with you. Most genealogists are gladly generous with their research, but, remember, it represents years of their hard work.

DON'T - say, "Send me everything you can find on the --- family and send me the bill". Professional genealogists won't accept a job on that basis alone but unscrupulous folks could send you a bill for hundreds of dollars.

DON'T - believe everything you see in print. We all try to be accurate, but the only requirement for a typeset, clothbound, archival-quality book is that it be paid for, not that it be accurate and truthful.

DON'T - expect every correspondent to be a pen pal. Just stick to the facts and save the chatty letters for friends and close relatives.

AND DO - have lots of fun!

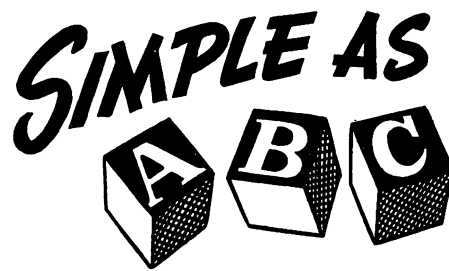

## OBITUARIES

Permission to print the following excerpts from "Obituaries: Last writes not right" found in the 52nd Issue, Fourth Quarter, 1989 of "The Harris News" was given by Jim Cook, Editor.

There are three events that virtually every Kansas newspaper considers "news" day in, day out. These are, in the vernacular, when anyone in the readership area is "bred, wed or dead". Births, weddings and death notices are news in their own right.

As Whitley Austin, long-time editor of The Salina Journal, wrote in a column about obituaries for The Journal, April 20, 1986, "For many persons, the function of the church is to put a touch of ceremony to the hatching, matching and dispatching. The same is true of newspapers".

By and large, death is the least well reported of news events despite the fact that the obit page is the most widely read page in most newspapers.

Mark Reddig, chief copy editor of The Hutchinson News, recently revised that paper's obituary policy with an eye toward increased accuracy.

The News, he said, considered rejecting death notices unless a cause of death was included, but chose against the idea after weighing the probable outcome against the value of publishing obituary information as a service to readers.

It would have been, in effect, a self defeating policy, he said.

Small newspapers often don't list the cause of death in obits because relatives don't want it known. Instead, obituaries often list "a lingering illness" or some other euphemism. A case in point: AIDS.

Still, inferences can be drawn if memorial funds are listed as part of the death notice. Listings requesting memorials to the American Cancer Society or donations to the Heart Fund often imply the cause of death.

## NO DEATHLESS PROSE HERE

Unless you're a reader of small country weeklies you'll seldom see euphemisms used in the obituary columns.

These days, people don't "go on to meet their maker." They aren't "called home by God." They just die.

But don't mourn the passing of the euphemism for "dead." It lives as Bruce Hilton wrote in the San Francisco Examiner, in the world of medicine:

A Canadian anesthesiologist turned the wrong knob, and the patient died. The report called it a "substantive negative outcome."

Consider "therapeutic misadventure." Or "diagnostic misadventure of the highest magnitude." Or "negative patient-care outcome."

Or the last note a doctor wrote on the chart of a newly dead patient: "Failed to fulfill his wellness potential."

## ROWAN COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA

The Family History Library (FHC) photographers have completed microfilming of the Loose Estate Papers of Rowan and Wake Counties, NC.

The Papers are of special value because they contain documents generated in the settlement of estates.

According to North Carolina law, if a person died without a will, an administrator was appointed by the court to oversee settlement of the estate. In some cases, even if there was a will, an administrator was appointed to assist an executor.

Guardian bonds for minor children may be included in the estate papers.

Other counties will be filmed with priority given to those with the largest & oldest collections.
