1798 DIRECT TAX FOR PENNSYLVANIA

A unique reference source for genealogists looking for late eighteenth century Pennsylvania residents is the 1798 Direct Tax. The original is at the National Archives in Record Group 58, Records of Internal Revenue Service.

Allegheny County, Green County, and Washington County can be found on Roll 24 of the microcopy from the National Archives.

OCTOBER SPEAKER DONALD J. BLAKESLEE

Donald J. Blakeslee is an Associate Professor in the Department of Anthropology at Wichita State University. He will speak on "Indian Trails: The Hidden Structure of Kansas History". Before Europeans arrived, many Indian trails crisscrossed the area that was to become Kansas. Later, explorers, trappers, and traders used the same routes. As the territory was settled and developed, trading posts and military forts were built along the trails, and pitched battles were fought near them. Travel Indian trails back in time for a fascinating view of our region's history.

Mr. Blakeslee specializes in archeology and ethnohistory of the Great Plains. His fieldwork has taken him to Montana, Wyoming, South Dakota, Nebraska, Oklahoma and Iowa. Recently, he has traveled thousands of miles reconstructing the route of two French-Canadian explorers who followed Indian trails from Illinois to the Southwest--one hundred years before the Santa Fe Trail.
