## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Have you seen the German word Ahnentafel meaning ancestor? At Ruth Filbert's urging I have been working on this type of ancestor chart. While it has been a good deal of work, I think it would help every genealogist to make one. It has advantages over working with the 5-generation ancestor charts in that it is possible to see immediately where names are missing in ones entire line. I was amazed to see that I had only one missing name in the first five generations. By keeping the chart in front of me as I am searching through genealogical books and magazines, I may find a lead to a family name I hadn't thought of before. I also found I had a common Jordon ancestor in three family lines.

To review what was in the last quarterly, your name is number 1; your parents are 2 & 3 and after that just double each number for each generation. Males are even numbered and females odd (naturally). It will make the job easier if your ancestor charts are filled in as much as possible before you start. Mine weren't. To save space in your chart, if you have a missing name just skip that number and go on. So come on relatives! help me fill in the blanks.

In our executive meeting, we have discussed other projects our society could be working on. There are several areas of information at the courthouse we need to record and get ready to publish--homestead naturalization and school records. Let us know if you are interested in helping.

**ALABAMA RESEARCH**—Since so little has been published for the state of Alabama, you may like to know that Margaret Matthews Cowart, 7801 Tea Garden Road SE, Huntsville, Alabama 35802 has published tract books for Colbert, Franklin, Jackson, Lawrence, Limestone, Madison, Marshall and Morgan. (TGS News & Views, Vol. 1, No. 1 Jan-Mar 1993 was the original source).

**AFRICAN-AMERICAN RESEARCH** - A good source for African-American families in Alabama and other areas of the south for the time period right after the civil war - Freedman's Bank found on National Archives microfilm M816-M817. The records of Mobile and Huntsville have survived. Tennessee has no voter registration books as it was restored to the Union by Congressional Act.

**KANSAS REVIEW** is presently printing GAR REGISTER 1894. Loss of the census for 1890 makes this a valuable source for persons seeking Kansas ancestors from that time period. This is a complete list of all Kansas counties.

**ADOPTION INFORMATION:** - Iowa has recently passed a law making adoption records accessible. Iowa House File #380 is a new law. " An Iowa adopted person whose adoption became final prior to July 4, 1941, and whose adoption record was not required to be sealed at the time of adoption shall not be required to show good cause for an order opening the adoption record." As it now stands, the adopted person and no one else may now apply for a court order without citing medical reasons, for example, as a need to obtain the record. Applications for the court order must be made in the county where the adoption occurred. If the county is not known, the adoptee can contact the Iowa Health Dept. and for a \$6 fee determine the county. This new law took effect July 1, 1991. (Greater Omaha NE newsletter.)

**ENGLISH AND AMERICAN OATHS OF FIDELITY AT SPANISH NATCHEZ, 1787.** Page 21. This article written by Winston De Ville contains many names of English and American residents of the Natchez, Mississippi area at the end of the American Revolution.

**TOPEKA GENEALOGICAL SOCIETY QUARTERLY**

**COUNTY-BY-COUNTY DIRECTORY OF KANSAS VITAL RECORDS** and Other Genealogical Materials Printed in Kansas Genealogical Periodicals. In April 1976, the T.G.S. Quarterly began a statewide finding aid for Kansas records - a listing of vital records and other genealogical materials printed by genealogical societies in KS. This has continued until the present time with the exception of 1979. The 1976 Directory included nine Kansas periodicals & one from Kansas City, MO. The current supplement includes 32 periodicals and one newsletter published by societies in Kansas.

**ANCESTORS UNLIMITED--SW NE GEN SOC.**

**BOUNTY LAND IN ILLINOIS**--Most of the land in Illinois was bounty land, given to veterans as a reward for their serving in wars between 1812 and 1856. Bounty land warrants may be ordered from the Federal Archives in Washington. Be sure to state that you are ordering the complete record. (Original hint from "Kinfolks", SW LA Gen. Soc.)

**COLONIAL RELATIONSHIPS** - The titles "Sr.", "Jr.", "III", etc., do not necessarily have the same meaning in colonial records as what they are used today. Often a "Jr." may have been a nephew, or a "Sr." an uncle. Many times the "Sr." and "Jr." were not even related. Also, when a "Sr." died, the "Jr." of the community became the "Sr.", and if there was a "III", he became "Jr."

Another relationship confusion is that of "father-in-law", "son-in-law", etc. In colonial times, a wife's father and mother became considered and referred to as father and mother of the husband as well, and vice versa. Consequently, references to a father and mother may be biologically, either the husband's or wife's. A "father-in-law" referred to the second husband of the spouse's mother. A "son-in-law" was the wife's son by a different marriage. Though there is no exact time when the nomenclature changed, careful research should help distinguish what the proper relationship should be. (From: Warren Co. Gen. Soc. - Indianola, IA)

**STATE MILITIA** - If a soldier served in a State Militia

Cont. which wasn't mustered into the Continental Army, the records (if available) may be found in the State Adjunct General's office in the state from which the soldier served. (Yorba Linda Gen. Soc.)

**SIGNING WITH AN "X"** - Signing a name with an "X" wasn't always an indication of illiteracy, according to the Handy Book of Literary Curiosities, published by Gale Research Co. Among the ancient Saxons, everyone, whether he could read and write or not, was required to make the sign of the cross after his signature as a proof of his good faith. (Linn Co. Heritage Hunters, Oct. 1992)

**GERMAN MAPS** - Write to Embassy of Germany, 4645 Reservoir Rd. NW, Washington, DC 20007. In addition to maps, they may provide an address of a genealogical organization in the area of your research. They include the former East and West Germany.

**A GERMAN EMIGRANTS REGISTER** may help one find unknown German places where their ancestors resided. The information is being entered onto database. For more information, write to Germanic Emigrants Register, P.O. Box 1720, E-2840 (W) Diepholz, Germany. (Both German hints from Root Diggers, NW Gen. Soc.)

\*\*\*\*\* **"WRIGLEY SURNAME"** \*\*\*\*\*

Is there a "WRIGLEY" in your family tree? Medical researchers have discovered that persons whose ancestry includes a WRIGLEY may have a unique protein in their blood that results in that person's blood cholesterol being very low (even as low as 17-35.) This property of the blood is called "Apo B 54 Protein" and other persons with WRIGLEY ancestry are being sought so that additional testing can be conducted. 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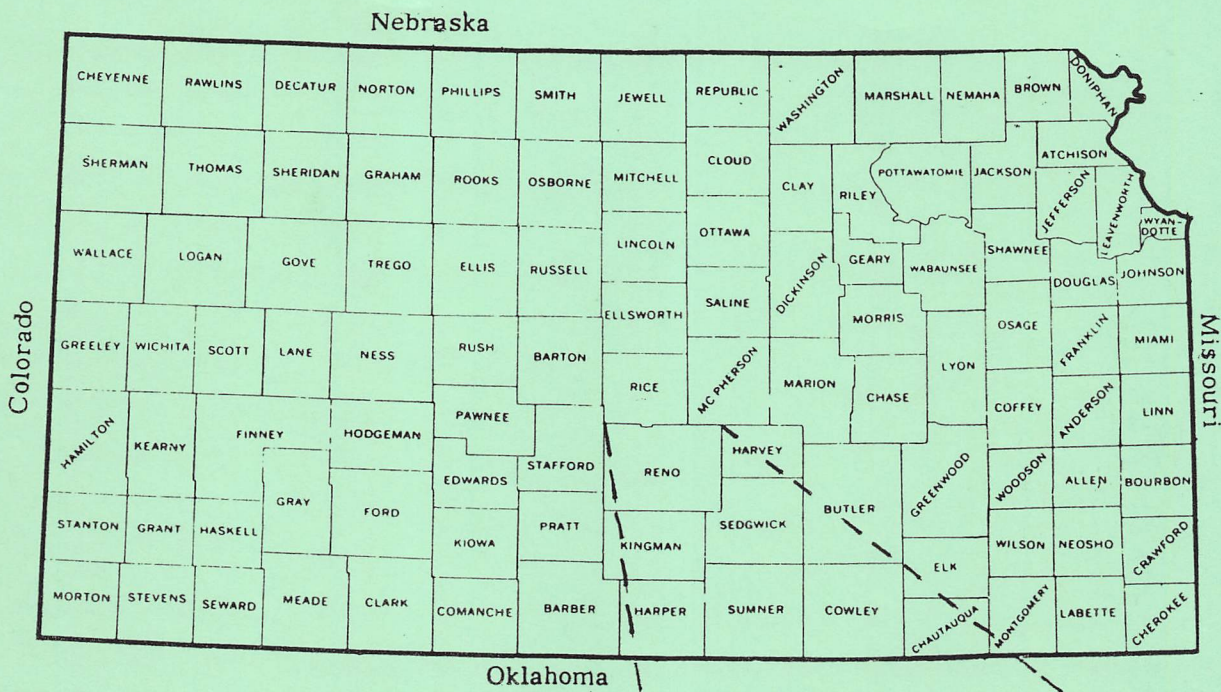

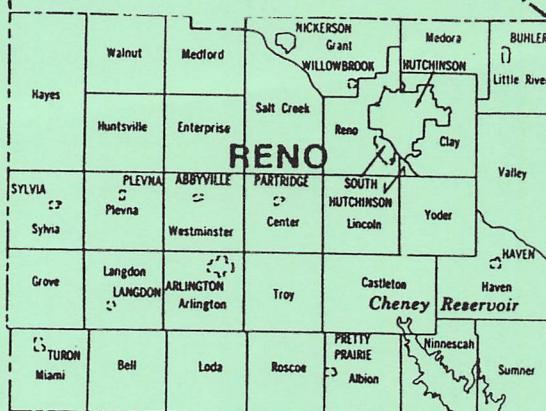
