Examples:

8:1:7. Ewell B. Grubbs of Baltimore, MD, died 1874 in CA.

8:1:9. Sophia Boggs, native of KY, married in MO, died CA 1874.

There is also a place to send British "Strays". A microfiche with a listing of "British Strays" is available at the FHC.

A check for \$50.00 will be presented to the first place winner in each of the following categories: Scholarly Composition; A Family History For the Family; and Family History Using a Computer Software Program. A check for \$25.00 will be issued to the first place winner in the Family Newsletter, My Ancestor Book; Ancestor Charts; Pictorial Ancestor Charts; Direct Line Pedigree Charts; and Descendancy Charts categories. The second, third and fourth place entries in each of the categories will receive certificates of participation.

FAMILY HISTORY/GENEALOGY AWARDS

GENERAL RULES

A. Each entry must have a Kansas connection.

- 1. The compiler must be the person entering the Kansas Council of Genealogical Societies Family History/Genealogical Awards Competition.
- 2. The compiler must be an affiliate member of the Kansas Council of Genealogical Societies (KCGS) or a member of a genealogical or historical society that is a member of the KCGS.
- 3. The compiler or at least one member of a family mentioned in the Family History Publications and Genealogies must live or have lived in Kansas.

B. Each entry must have the name, address, and phone number of the submitter attached to it. (This will allow other genealogists who are interested in your surnames to contact you.)

C. Compositions will be judged, based on the category, according to a standard composition handbook. Example: the "MLA for Writers of Research Papers" or "Publication manual of the American Psychological Association" for the Scholarly Composition and "WRITE IT RIGHT" and "CITE YOUR SOURCES" for the categories: A Family History For the Family; Family History Using a Computer Software Program; and Family Newsletter.

D. All genealogical charts should be prepared according to the guidelines found in a standard genealogical handbook.

- 1. Photocopies of genealogical charts will be accepted.
- 2. All entries, including photocopies, must be legible.
- 3. Typed charts (can be computer generated) and hand printing are the preferred methods, but cursive and calligraphy (fancy handwriting) will be accepted. Use a pen with black ink to make hand written charts.

How to submit an entry.

1. All Family History Publications, Newsletters and Genealogy Charts must be sent to the Family History/Genealogy committee chairman, Ruth Hair Filbert, 1519 Willow Road, Hutchinson, KS 67502-2613 by the 1st of April 1997.
2. The award winning publications will be displayed at the KCGS Annual Conference.

Do not send an entry that is an original or one of a kind.

1. All entries will become the property of the Kansas Council of Genealogical societies.
2. The entries will become a part of the Kansas Council of Genealogical Societies Collection at the Kansas State Historical Society Library and Archives.

PUBLICATIONS

I. FAMILY HISTORY PUBLICATIONS

A. Family History -- A Scholarly Composition

1. All entries will be judged according to the guidelines found in the "MLA Handbook for Writers of Research Papers" or the "Publication manual of the American Psychological Association".
2. Documentation -- Full documentation (birth, marriage and death certificates, bible records, obituaries, census, etc.) will be required for the first five (5) generations. Documentation or a preponderance of evidence for the remaining ancestors should be shown. (Preponderance of evidence should list three reasons to support an event date and place.)
3. A numbering systems.
A full explanation of the numbering system and an example of how it is used shall be included in the book.
4. All pictures shall be numbered and the persons shown in the picture should be identified, if possible, in the caption under the picture. The page number where that picture is described should also be noted in the caption.
5. The book must contain an ancestor chart or direct line ancestry chart and a descendency chart as part of the composition or an ancestor chart or direct line ancestry chart and a descendency chart printed seperately must be securely attached to the back pages of the book.

B. Family History -- A Book For Family Members.

1. This entry will be judged according to the suggestions found in "Cite Your Sources" and "Write It Right".
2. Documentation - Full documentation (birth, marriage, and death certificates, or their equivalent or a preponderance of evidence) for the first five (5) generations (compiler or youngest generation plus his/her next four ancestors) shall be included.
3. A numbering system shall be used and somewhere in the book there shall be an explanation of the numbering system and how to use it.

4. Pictures - The caption under a picture should include a number identifying that picture. This number will be used in the body of the text that describes the picture. All persons in the picture shall be identified, if possible. If the identity of a person or persons is unknown, state that fact.

C. Family History -- Using a Computer Generated Software, such as KinWrite®, KinPublish®, Gen-Book®, etc.

1. Without the use of any other word processing software to enhance the composition.
2. With the use of other software, such as WordPerfect® or Microsoft Word®.

D. Family Newsletter -- Newsletters for One Year

The Family Newsletter entries will be judged by the following standards.

1. Title page with the name, address and phone number of the editor, volume and issue number, purpose of the newsletter and what information will be included in the newsletter. If family news is solicited, state the cut-off date for inclusion in the next issue.
2. Table of contents.
3. Yearly Index.
4. Pictures. All persons shown in the pictures should be identified and relationships noted.

GENEALOGIES

I. GENEALOGY

A. My Ancestor Book -- All Direct Ancestry Surnames. A Book Composed of Ancestor Charts and Their Corresponding Family Group Sheets.

1. The ancestor chart/s must be in print format.
2. Person No. 1 on the ancestor chart must be the compiler or a descendant of the compiler.

3. There must be a Family Group Sheet for each ancestral couple shown on the ancestor chart/s.
4. The information for the first five (5) generations must be fully documented or show a preponderance of evidence. Documentation or a preponderance of evidence should be shown for all other generations, if possible.
5. Pictures, if they are included in the book, should clearly identify the persons shown in relationship to the Family Group Sheet.
6. The name and address of the compiler should be shown on the first page of the book.

B. Ancestor Charts

1. 5 or 10 generation ancestor charts.
 - a. The information must be legible. It can be in either cursive or print format.
 - b. The name and address of the compiler must be on the chart.
2. Documentation or a preponderance of evidence must be shown for the first five (5) generations and should be shown for the remaining generations.

C. Pictorial Ancestor Chart

1. 5 generation chart.
 - a. The chart should be arranged so that each generation can be clearly identified.
 - b. Each ancestor must be identified and the relationship to the compiler noted.
 - c. The name and address of the compiler should be on the chart.
2. Documentation or a preponderance of evidence must be shown.

D. Direct Line Pedigree Charts

1. 5 - 10 or 15 generation charts.
 - a. The name and address of the compiler must be on the chart.
 - b. Documentation or a preponderance of evidence must be shown for the first five generations and should be shown for the remaining generations shown.

E. Descendancy Chart

1. Descendancy charts of 5 generations or over will be accepted.
2. The name and address of the compiler must be on or attached to the chart.
3. Documentation or a preponderance of evidence must be shown for the first five generations and should be shown for the remaining generations shown.

▪ *In Congress...* ▪

Have you ever wondered why the Bill of Rights refers to "Congrefs" instead of "Congress?" The reason: Blame it on the "Long S." Two hundred years ago it was common to write an "s" with a long "s." The person who set the type used an "f" instead of the "long s". That was OK for the reader of the day but guaranteed to confuse and confound us. For instance, the word "same" appears as "fame", and "castle" became "caftle." Maps referred to "New Jerfey" and "Penfilvania." In the 1791 Bradford edition of Thomas Paine's *Common Sense*, the Introduction reads: "Perhaps the fentiments contained in the following pages, are not yet fufficiently fashionable to procure them general favor..." This is one reason surnames can have different spellings. "Ness" became "Neff."

When asked about this rather curious method of spelling, an historian explained that the "s" in those days was known as a "Long S." It seems that after the invention of movable type, the alphabet guides created in the 1600's showed the "s" to be different from the "f". So far, so good. However....and here's what got them into trouble... when the "s" was written out by hand, it came out looking like an "f." When the typeface for printing was created, the typemakers naturally copied what had been done by hand. Result: the "s" and "f" appeared almost identical so the printers used them interchangeably. It wasn't until about 1800 that the "Long S" disappeared. From that time to the present readers never again confused the two.
